

Consider the Complex Care Needs Protocol

Infant identified as weight faltering according to NICE 2017 Weight Faltering guidelines https://www.nice.org.uk/guidance/ng75

HV/FN deliver universal pathway. Full feeding history, relevant medical information, feeding diary, review of weight with length and head circumference. Implement feeding plan

Exclusions - if the child is under review of paediatrics or dietetics (unless GNAS review is requested directly from these services)



Growth and Nutrition Advisory Service to review referral, feeding diary, care plan & growth data at weekly MDT on Thursday morning and advise referrer on outcome
